Toronto, ON – NoticeConnect has launched a new feature that lets estate practitioners publish 'Knowledge of a Will' notices online at noticeconnect.com.

When someone dies, it's important for estate practitioners and administrators to determine if there was a will, and if they have the most recent copy of that will. Administering an estate as intestate or with an outdated will – only for a previously unknown will to surface later – can result in liability and administrative headaches.

The notices are published online in NoticeConnect's searchable public database, republished on social media, and emailed weekly to subscribers. Anyone can subscribe for free at www.noticeconnect.com/willnotices to receive an email every Tuesday morning with links to the new Knowledge of a Will notices on the site.

Publication costs \$130 and commissioned affidavits of publication are available.
